



# Wisconsin Department of Transportation

## WIS 167 Resurfacing – I-41 to Wasaukee Rd

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to improve approximately 4.6 miles of WIS 167 in Washington County.

The purpose of the project is to address deteriorating pavement and decreased ride quality on WIS 167, to update and improve pedestrian accommodations along the corridor, and to upgrade the traffic signals.

### Proposed Improvements:

- Mill & overlay 3-inches WIS 167 from I-41 E On/Off Ramps to S WIS 145.
- Mill & overlay 2 ½-inches of WIS 167 from WIS 145 to Wasaukee Road.
- Replace traffic signals and implement intersection operational improvements at six intersections on WIS 167.
- Add or update existing pedestrian accommodations (sidewalks & curb ramps).
- Replace guardrail and perform maintenance at existing storm water culverts.
- Replace the crossing surface for one at-grade railroad crossing on WIS 167.

Construction is anticipated to start in Spring 2029.
