

**GERMANTOWN  
BLASTING PERMIT**

TEMPORARY BLASTING PERMIT.

PERMIT REQUIRED. No person shall mine or extract rock without first obtaining a conditional use permit issued pursuant to secs. 17.36 and 17.42 of this Code and a mining operation permit pursuant to sec. 12.18 of this Code, or a temporary rock crushing and blasting permit from the Director of Public Works pursuant to this section.

APPLICATION AND FEE. Application for a permit shall be made on forms provided by the Director of Public Works and be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00.

TERM OF PERMIT. The permit shall expire 90 days from the date of issuance, unless lesser or greater time is approved.

If explosives are to be stored in Germantown, the proper State and Federal forms shall be furnished to the Village Police Department, Village Fire Department, and be attached to this permit request.

Appropriate Certificate of Insurance shall be issued to the Village Police Department, Village Fire Department, and be attached to this permit request.

A "Notice Of Blasting In Community" shall be furnished to the Village Police Department, Village Fire Department, and be attached to this permit request.

The hours of operation shall be 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, but excluding holidays.

Responsible blaster shall meet all Local, State and Federal regulations.

A copy of Village Ordinance 12-97 is hereby acknowledged by the blaster.
