Describe the proposed use, including size, number of employees, hours of operation and extent of any new construction/alterations.

Clean Harbors collects hazardous and nonhazardous solid wastes from generators (our customers). Containers of wastes (5 Gallon -350 Gallon) are managed under a truck-to-truck transfer where the wastes are collected by Clean Harbors employees in collection vehicles, transported to the Germantown site where these wastes will be consolidated on a staged outbound trailer for offsite shipment. Covered bulk bins may also be stored temporarily prior to shipment for offsite disposal. Clean Harbors will also be cleaning various types of rented Containers and Frac Tanks before returning to Owner. Approximately 25 employees will work at the site and hours will be Monday-Friday, 7AM - 5PM. At no time, will any waste containers be opened onsite nor will there be any waste processing of any kind.
