Performance Target:

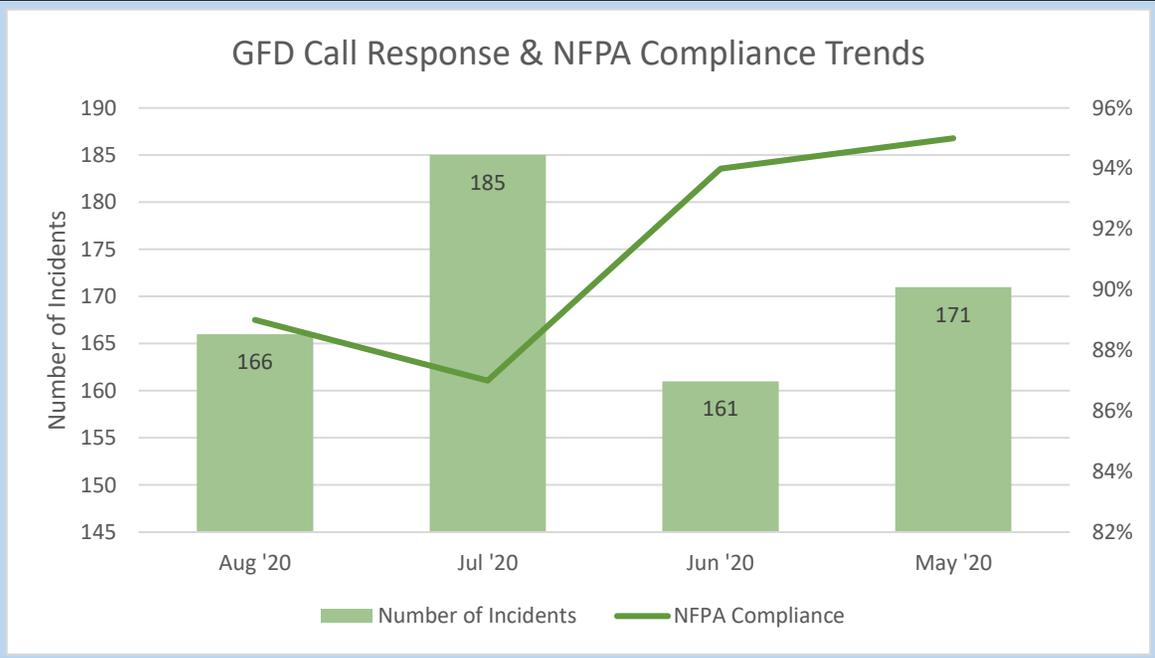
Arrival of crews within 8 minutes according to NFPA 1710 standard, and within 5:20 minutes per ISO Guidelines. (NFPA standard is 90%)

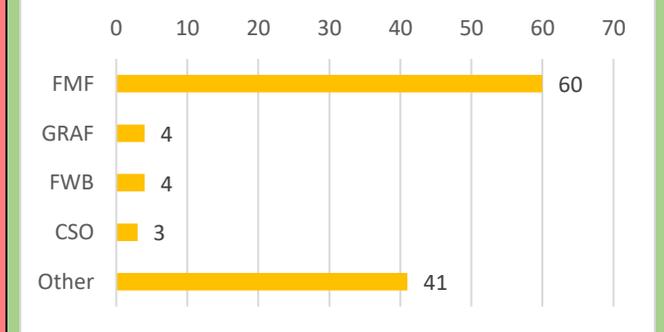
Analysis:

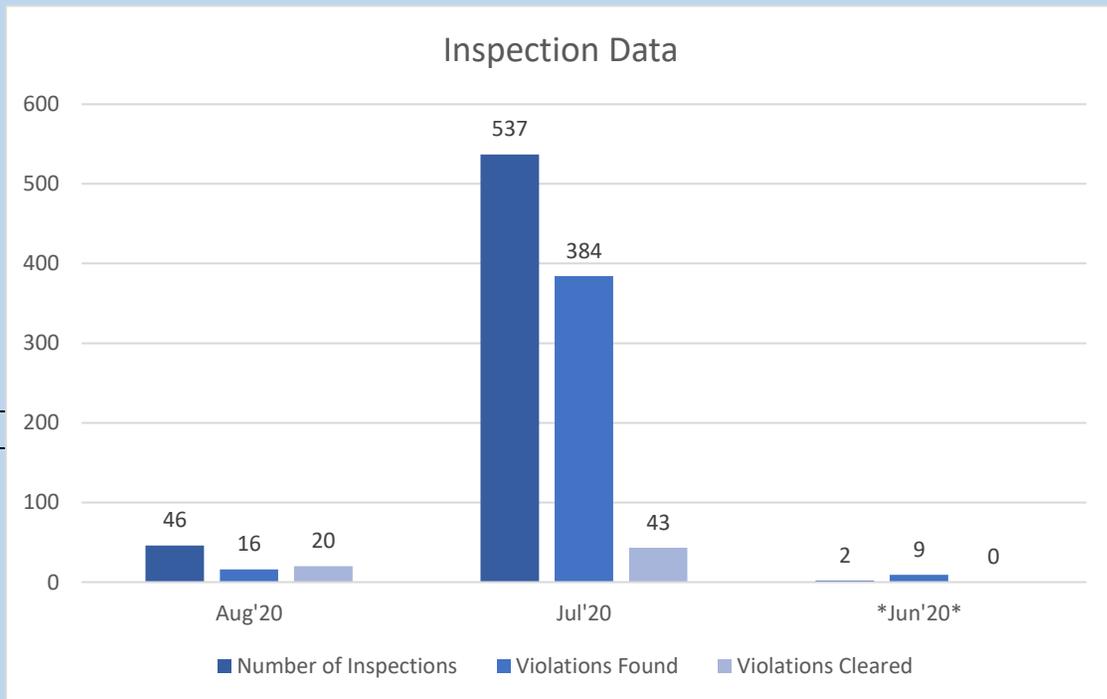

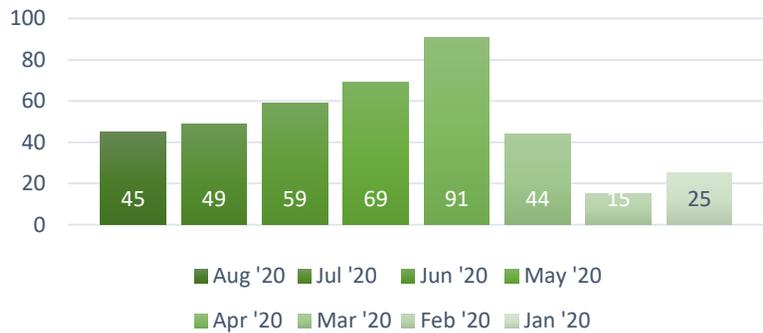

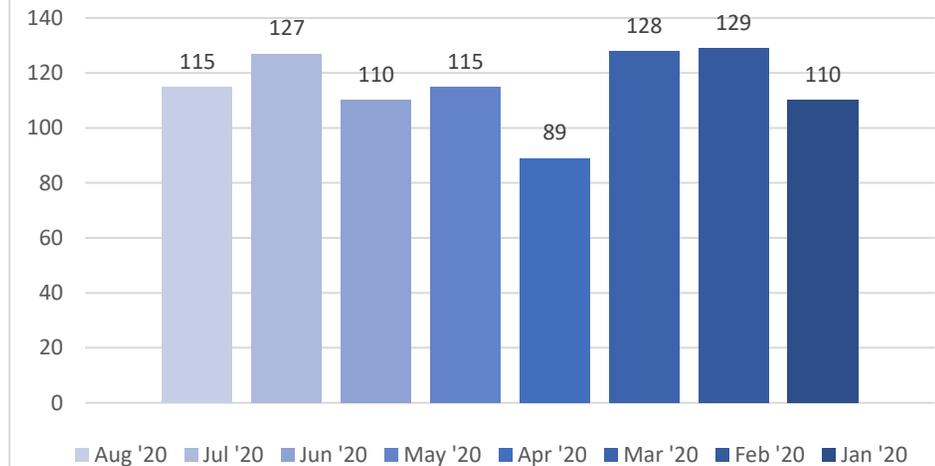
