The purpose of said hearing will be to hear any and all parties, their attorneys or agents, for or against the petition filed by the Village of Germantown Community Development Department for a proposed text amendment to the following sections of the Zoning Code (Chapter 17) of the Village of Germantown Municipal Code: 17.50(2)(f), 17.50(2)(h) and 17.41(6) regarding fences, hedges and retaining walls in residential districts; 17.46(7)(h) regarding Electronic Message Center (EMC) signs; and 17.59 regarding Animal Waste Storage Facilities (new code section).
