# COUNTY LINE ROAD to CLOSE OVERNIGHT



## Bridge Paving and Roadway Repairs Scheduled

### Project Status

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with a series of road improvement projects in Washington County. The following work is scheduled as part of these improvement projects.

**Monday, September 18, through Wednesday, September 20, and Friday September 22:**

- County Line Road between Rivercrest Drive and Cumberland Road is scheduled to close to traffic overnight.
- The entrance and exit ramps at I-41 and County Line Road are scheduled to close to traffic overnight.
- The intersection of Falls Parkway and County Line Road is scheduled to close to traffic overnight.

Westbound County Line Road over I-41 is scheduled to remain closed until late September.

### Detour Route

- » Motorists are encouraged to use Lannon/Mequon roads (WIS 167), Appleton Avenue (WIS 175), Main Street and Pilgrim Road to get around these closures.

*Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.*
