

RESPONSE




Did you know?

The word *curfew* originated in the 14th century, when an evening bell would warn people to cover their hearth fires for the night, to protect their homes (and their neighbor's homes) from accidental fires. It comes from the Anglo-French *coverfeu*, which is itself from the words *coverir* ("to cover") and *feu* ("fire").

Call volume "Heat Map" indicating incidents in the Village by Zone.


