### Direct Charges:

The Wisconsin Public Service Commission (PSC) assigns certain regional assets for the utility to provide large volumes of water for a fire. This might include larger-than-necessary water mains, increased size of pumps at booster stations, and larger volumes at water towers and tanks, as well as fire hydrants for firefighting. Under Wis. Stat. § 196.03(3)(b), the Village Board has chosen to have the utility bill the remaining public fire protection service charge to the retail general service customers. A portion of the Direct Charges or Public Fire Protection will remain on the tax levy, the remaining will be charged as below:
