


RESPONSE

We want to express our gratitude for the help your department provided at a house fire in our community on the evening of Sunday, March 9.

The on-scene crews did a great job of minimizing loss (to the extent possible) for the homeowners, who were able to recover many of their personal effects and important documents after the fire was extinguished. While the insurance company will have to complete its investigation, initial findings thus far are consistent with a rechargeable battery pack (and its plugged-in charger) possibly serving as the ignition source for the fire.

As always, I am thoroughly impressed by the level of collaboration, cooperation, and professionalism exhibited by all our MABAS partners and appreciate the willingness of your fire department and its members to assist us in whatever capacity is required when we need help.


