- (1) Plan Commission meetings are held in the Village Board Meeting Room at the Germantown Village Hall, N112 W17001 Mequon Road. Meetings start at 6:30 pm MEETING and DEADLINE DATES are subject to change.
- (2) All applications (including forms, fees, plans, reports, etc.) must be submitted AND deemed complete by Village Staff on or before the DEADLINE DATE in order to be scheduled on the corresponding MEETING DATE. Submitting an application on or even a few days before the DEADLINE DATE does NOT guarantee that the application will be deemed complete in time to be put on the agenda for the corresponding MEETING DATE. Incomplete applications will not be scheduled on an agenda regardless of when they are submitted. Applicants are encouraged to NOT wait until the DEADLINE DATE to submit an application. Pre-application discussions and/or meetings with Village staff are encouraged (or may be required) depending on the size or complexity of a project or application. Applications can be submitted to the Planning Department on any day during normal business hours but not later than 4:00 pm on the DEADLINE DATE.  
NOTE: Applications submitted after 4:00 pm or within 2 days after a DEADLINE DATE may be deemed complete and added to the agenda for the next available MEETING DATE with payment of an additional late fee depending on available staff time.
- (3) All applications submitted to the department requiring Plan Commission review and approval shall include a complete digital copy (PDF/CD/USB/Dropbox) of all applications and supporting documents (including all plans, reports, surveys, etc.) submitted at the time of application or sent via e-mail within 3 days after the date of application.
- (4) The following applications submitted for Plan Commission review and approval shall include a Word-formatted digital file of the subject property's legal description: Certified Survey Map, Conditional Use Permit, Land Use Plan Map Amendment, Rezoning/Planned Development District (PDD), and Subdivision Plat.
- (5) Regularly scheduled meeting dates are the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of each month. In the event that a special meeting is required, the Plan Commission may meet on the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday.
